



RANGE RULES

1. All personnel must correctly wear approved protection for ears and eyes before entering any shooting range.
2. A range officer will inspect all firearms before the firearm may be allowed into the firing line area.
3. All personnel must follow all instruction from the range control officer and their range safety officers.
4. All personnel may not approach or cross the firing line without permission from the range control officer or a range safety officer.
5. Target Placement: All personnel will place their target using a facility target frame, and ensure that there is sufficient backstop sand material behind the target to absorb all shots.
6. Aiming at anything other than the designated target for an assigned lane is cause for ejection by the range control officer and suspension from the Rod and Gun Club until review and reinstatement by the Rod and Gun Club Manager.
7. If the range control officer declares that a range is COLD, all personnel will ensure that their firearm is unloaded and in a non-firing status and all personnel will ensure that the range control officer knows that their firearm is CLEAR.
8. All personnel will clean their shooting station when they are finished; i.e., return target frame from backstop to firing line area, pick up all expended cartridges and dispose of inside, in the club house brass container.
9. The range control officer or their range safety officer will check all firearms to ensure that they are clear before anyone may remove the firearm from the firing line area.
10. The Rod & Gun Club Manager is the senior range control officer and may add to these rules at any time.
