

Palace Chase



- Request to leave active duty early.
- Speak to your in-service recruiter.(Me)
- Must complete ½ of initial enlistment
 –or- 2/3 of initial ADSC
- Commitment is 2x (E) / 3x (O) your remaining AD time
- Retrain if you want to.
- Open to <u>all</u> AFSC's to apply.
- Must apply in your DEROS Window

DEROS Windows



Officers

- Rule A: DEROS/ADSCSame month/year
 - Application Window
 12 15 mo prior to
 DEROS
- Rule B: DEROS ADSC don't match
 - Application Window 9-12 mo prior to DEROS

Enlisted

- Rule A: DEROS/DOSSame month/year
 - Application Window
 12 15 mo prior to
 DEROS
- Rule B: DEROS ADSC don't match
 - Application Window 6-9 mo prior to DEROS

Palace Front



- Initiate 12 months prior to your DOS.
- Separate the Air Force one day and be assigned to the Reserve the next.
- Complete your military service obligation.
- Serve a minimum of 39 days a year.
- Retrain if you want to.
- You can quit if you don't like it!

Part Time

Traditional Reserve (TR)

1 weekend a month, 1 Annual Tour (2 weeks a year) – Total: 39 Days

- Stationed near the home of your choice
- Regular Monthly income
- Part of Cohesive Unit
- Cross Train opportunities

Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA) Flexible Schedule- 48 IDT (24 days) and 14 annual tour day (26)

Can be attached to a unit geographically separated from you Home of Record

Full Time

Air Reserve Technician (ART)

- Full time civil servant M-F (WG Pay Scale)
- Reserve member 1 weekend per month.
- Two Retirements!

Active Guard & Reserve (AGR)

- Same pay and benefits as active duty.
- Earn an active duty retirement after 20 years.
